Presenoldeb 92-95%	O leiaf 2 wythnos o ddysgu wedi ei golli	Efallai y bydd yn rhaid i'ch plentyn dreulio amser yn dal i fyny a'r gwaith.
Presenoldeb 85-92%	O leiaf 4 wythnos o ddysgu wedi ei golli	Efallai y bydd eich plentyn mewn perygl o dangyflawni ac efallai y bydd angen Cymorth ychwanegol wrtho chi i ddal i fyny a'r gwaith. Fe fyddwch yn derbyn cyfathrebiad wrth yr ysgol os fydd presenoldeb eich plentyn o dan 92%
Presenoldeb 80-85%	O leiaf 5 ½ wythnos o ddysgu wedi ei golli	Mae presenoldeb eich plentyn yn cael effaith sylweddol ar ei (d)dysgu. Fe fyddwch yn derbyn llythyr wrth yr ysgol os fydd presenoldeb eich plentyn o dan 85%.
Presenoldeb o dan 80%	O leiaf 7 ½ wythnos o ddysgu wedi ei golli	Mae'ch plentyn yn colli allan ar addysg eang a chytbwys. Fe fydd yr ysgol yn cysylltu a chi er mwyn gweld sut allwn eich cefnogi i gynyddu presenoldeb eich plentyn.

Your child's Attendance

Attendance is one of the factors that is considered when discussing how much progress each pupil has made within their work and developing everyday skills and the effect this has on the pupil's education.

At the beginning of a new term, we continue as a Federation to focus on each pupil's attendance as well as other factors to ensure that each pupils receives the best education and opportunities to reach their potential. You will notice regular references to attendance within the weekly letters and we will inform each school of the overall attendance at the end of each month. Regular communication in accordance with local authority guidelines will also raise your awareness as parents of attendance which is decreasing. Below is a table from the local authority which notes some possible effects on pupil's attendance.

Please note that the use of the table is dependent on the circumstances that has been discussed during the focused month: e.g. an informal conversation has already taken place, school is already aware of the situation – you will not receive another call or letter if this is the case.

Attendance 95 - 100%	Best chance of success	Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.
Attendance 92-95%	At least 2 weeks of learning missed	Your child may have to spend time catching up with work.
Attendance 85-92%	At least 4 weeks of learning missed	Your child may be at risk of underachieving and may need extra support from you to catch up with work. You will receive communication from the school if you child's attendance reaches below 92%.
Attendance 80-85%	At least 5 ½ weeks of learning missed	Yours child's attendance has a significant impact on learning. You will receive a letter from the school if you child's attendance reaches below 85%.
Attendance of under 80%	At least 7 ½ weeks of learning missed	Your child is missing out on a broad and balanced education. The school will be in contact to see if we can support you in anyway to raise your child's attendance.
