**What does Transition look like for a learner in the Bro Dinefwr cluster?**

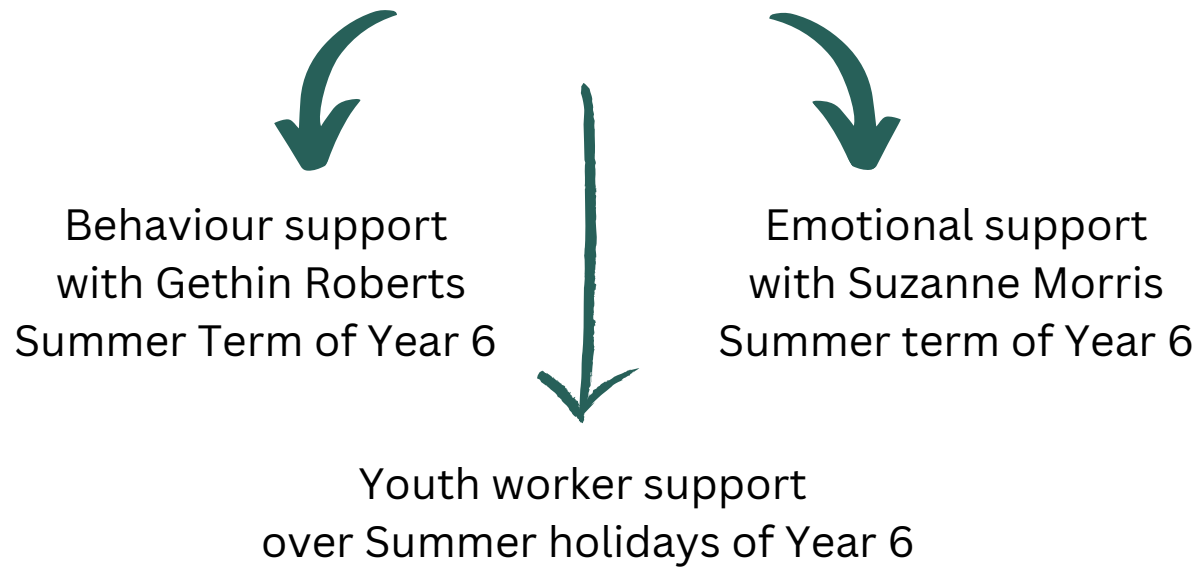


# A continuation...
