



Beth yw yr Urdd?

Mudiad yw yr Urdd sydd wedi bodoli ers 1922. Mae'n fudiad sydd yn unigryw i Gymru ac sy'n cynnig cyfleoedd amrywiol i ieuencid Cymru hyd at 26 oed. Mae gan yr Urdd arwyddair – i Gymru, i Gyd-ddyn, i Grist a mae symbol o driongl gwyn, coch a gwyrdd ynghyd a cymeriad o'r un lliwiau Mr Urdd.

Mae gan yr Urdd wersylloedd preswyl ac yn flynyddol cynnigir i Flwyddyn 4 a 5 i ymweld a'r gwersyll i fwynhau gweithgareddau awyr agored. Cynnigir amserlen o gyfleoedd chwaraeon i ddisgyblion hyn yr ysgol gan gynnwys nofio, gymnasteg, pel droed, rygbi a phel rwyd.

Yn flynyddol cynnigir i ddisgyblion ymaelodi a'r urdd er mwyn cael cyfleoedd i gystadlu ac i fynychu clwb yr Urdd. Cost 2023-24 yw £10 (£1 os ydy eich plentyn yn deilwng i brydiau ysgol am ddim) a gellir ymuno trwy ddilyn y linc <https://www.urdd.cymru/cy/ymuno/>

Prif ddigwyddiad blynyddol yr Urdd yw yr Eisteddfod a gynhelir am wythnos yn ystod Sulgwyn. Yn flynyddol mae'r lleoliad yn newid rhwng y de a'r gogledd. Eleni mae'r Eisteddfod yn Sir Faldwyn.

Prif fwriad ein clybiau ysgol yw datblygu sgiliau, cynnal gweithgareddau gwahanol trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg a hefyd cynnig cyfleoedd i'r disgyblion wetihio ar brosiectau celf grwp a dysgu ar gyfer perfformiadau torfol megis cor, cyd adroddm dawnsio gyda'r pinacl sef cystadlu yn yr Eisteddfod lleol yn y gobaith o symud ymlaen i'r ail rownd ac i'r Eisteddfod Fawr yn mis Mai.



What is the Urdd?

The Urdd is a movement that has existed since 1922. It is a movement unique to Wales and offers diverse opportunities for Welsh youth up to the age of 26. The Urdd has a motto – For Wales, For All Man, for Christ and there is a symbol of a white, red, and green triangle together with a character of the same colours Mr Urdd.

The Urdd has residential camps and Llangrannog camp is annually offered to Year 4 and 5 to visit and enjoy outdoor activities. The older school pupils are offered a schedule of sports competitions including swimming, gymnastics, football, rugby and netball.

Pupils are offered to join the Urdd to have opportunities to compete and to attend the Urdd club. The cost of 2022-23 is £10 (£1 if your child is eligible for free school meals) and payment of membership can be made by following the link <https://www.urdd.cymru/cy/ymuno/>

The Urdd's main annual event is the Eisteddfod which takes place for a week during Whitsun half term. Annually the location changes between south and north Wales. This year the Eisteddfod is in Carmarthenshire (Llandovery) so it's very local for us within the Federation.

The main intention of our school clubs is to develop skills, to offer different activities through the medium of Welsh and to provide opportunities for pupils to work on group art projects to compete and learn for group performances such as choir, group recitation and dancing with the pinnacle, competing in the local Eisteddfod in the hope of progressing to the second round and to the National Eisteddfod in May.

All pupils who have joined the Urdd since September have been invited to the club which starts next week. Check with the school what year groups can attend the club.
